She lectures on creating inclusive spaces, delivers professional development for teachers and admin regarding best practices and policies to create better and safer schools, helps community organizations develop inclusive practices, and through the fYrefly in Schools program works with teachers to offer workshops on gender and sexual diversity to students of all ages.
