- Lifetouch Photography has advised there is a delay with their lab loading our school photos for viewing. They advised it is taking approximately 3 weeks before families will be able to view the photos. You will require your child's 8 digit student ID number to view the photos. This number can be found in your child's agenda as an entry earlier this week, as well as on your Parent Portal account, on the School Fees tab. Subsequently, we have delayed our Retake Day to Friday November 3rd.
- Early Arrival of Students: Morning Supervision does not begin until 8:40 a.m. at which time the exterior doors to the school are unlocked. Students are welcome to enter the school at that time through their designated door and teachers will be in their classrooms to receive students at that time. It is becoming more frequent that students are arriving at school early. Students will be advised to wait outside at their designated entry door until the bell rings to come in. If there is inclement weather, we may open the doors earlier so students are not waiting outside in the rain or very cold temperatures.
- Student Early Pickup: If you are picking up your child early, please call from your vehicle when you arrive or check in at the office. Students do stay in their classrooms until your arrival. Please allow a few extra minutes in your schedule for your child to make their way down from the classroom.
