- Student Safety is of utmost importance to all staff at LEH. A large part of ensuring student safety is parent engagement. Please pay attention to no parking areas during the day. A reminder that the bus lane in front of the school is a No Stopping/Parking Zone from 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on school days. Parent parking is available on Everitt Drive, or in our Kiss & Go through lane.

We understand that the Kiss & Go Lane is a very busy area at the end of the school day. There is no parking on the right side of the lane as you enter the Kiss & Go, and we ask that parents move up the lane as space becomes available so Everitt Drive traffic is not blocked. Please be kind and patient with our Staff Supervisors as they work to assist students to safely meet up with their Parents in the Kiss & Go Lane.

- Late Student Drop Off/Early Student Pickup: If your child is arriving late to school, please enter through the front doors. Please ring the Admin doorbell for the front office, and have your child check in with the office before proceeding to their classroom. For early pickups, please call from your vehicle or ring the doorbell and enter the office. Students will remain in their classroom until you have arrived. Please use the SIGIS doorbell for all childcare drop-offs and pick-ups.
