- Hot Lunch is starting up again and our first hot lunch date will be Tuesday September 24th. Healthy Hunger is now active. Please log on to order your child's hot lunch. For our new students, our Friends of LEH group have parent volunteers who coordinate the hot lunch for our school every Tuesday and Thursday. Orders must be placed online through your Healthy Hunger account. Please visit healthyhunger.ca

If your child is going to be away on a day they are to have hot lunch, you cancel your order through Healthy Hunger if it is 5 days in advance. If it is the day of the hot lunch, please email the hot lunch coordinator by 11:00 a.m. at lehhotlunchcoordinator@gmail.com to advise if you would like your child's lunch in the office for you to pick up, if you would like it given to a sibling or another student, or if the lunch can be donated. Lunches cannot be held so if there has been no communication by 11:00 a.m., the coordinators will donate the lunch.

- Student Safety is of utmost importance to all staff at LEH. A large part of ensuring student safety is parent engagement. Please pay attention to no parking areas during the day. A reminder that the bus lane in front of the school is a No Stopping/Parking Zone from 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on school days. Parent parking is available on Everitt Drive, or in our Kiss & Go through lane. We understand that the Kiss & Go Lane is a very busy area at the end of the school day. There is no parking on the right side of the lane as you enter the Kiss & Go, and we ask that parents move up the lane as space becomes available so Everitt Drive traffic is not blocked. Please be kind and patient with our Staff Supervisors as they work to assist students to safely meet up with their Parents in the Kiss & Go Lane.
- Late Student Drop Off/Early Student Pickup: If your child is arriving late to school, please enter through the front doors. Please ring the Admin doorbell for the front office, and have your child check in with the office before proceeding to their classroom. For early pickups, please call from your vehicle or ring the doorbell and enter the office. Students will remain in their classroom until you have arrived. Please use the SIGIS doorbell for all childcare drop-offs and pick-ups.
