Canadian Dental Care Plan Régime canadien de soins dentaires

Hello,

We are happy to provide you with information on the **Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP)** and upcoming information sessions.

As you may be aware, the interim Canada Dental Benefit—which provided payments of up to \$650 per eligible child under 12 to help cover the cost of oral health care—ended on June 30, 2024. However, the Government of Canada launched the CDCP to help make the cost of oral health care more affordable for up to 9 million Canadian residents of all ages.

The great news is that applications for **children under 18** are now open, and parents/guardians are invited to apply on their behalf at <u>Canada.ca/dental</u>, provided they meet the CDCP eligibility <u>criteria</u>. Those who can't apply online may do so by phone at 1-833-537-4342. For TTY, call 1-833-677-6262. Applicants can also call these numbers to request alternative formats such as large print, braille, e-text, audio/video, and DAISY.

Once the application is received and eligibility has been confirmed, information on the applicant will be sent to Sun Life, who will enrol them as a CDCP client. Sun Life will then send the CDCP client a welcome package that includes information on the plan, a CDCP member card, and the benefit start date (coverage start date). Those who've applied can check on the status of their application using the <u>Status Checker</u>.

After receiving the welcome package, CDCP clients can visit an oral health provider of their choice, as long as their provider can bill and agrees to receive payment directly from Sun Life for services covered under the CDCP. Those who don't already have an oral health provider can find one by using the <u>CDCP Provider Search Tool</u> or by calling Sun Life at 1-888-888-8110. It is important that **parents ensure their child's coverage is in effect before they book an appointment**.

The CDCP is not a free dental care plan but helps makes the cost of oral health care more affordable. It is important for CDCP clients not to pay the full amount upfront to their providers as they will not be reimbursed by the plan. CDCP clients are only required to pay any outstanding amounts not covered by the plan in addition to their co-payment, as applicable.
