School councils work to support parental involvement in the school community in an advisory role. They provide a way for members of the community to consult with and offer advice to principals and school boards.

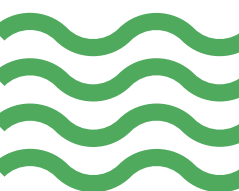
School councils are legislated under the Education Act and are mandatory for all schools in the public education system.




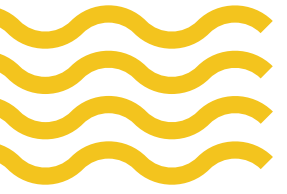
Meetings are usually the **fourth Monday of every month** in the school year from **7 p.m.–9 p.m.** in the LEH staffroom

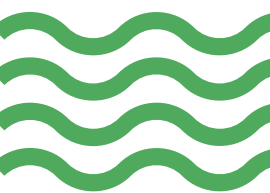
Fundraisers

LEH Friends Society

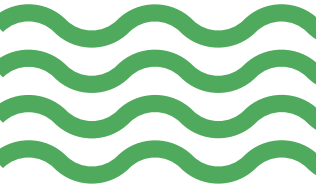


LEH Friends Society hosts a number of annual community events, such as:
